



Mount Engadine Lodge is looking for people who want to work in an award winning lodge and take care of our guests with their enthusiastic and personable service skills.

The lodge is located in Spray Valley Provincial Park, a 45 minute drive from Canmore and is considered a back country lodge with front country access.

There is no television or cell service at the lodge and the closest store is in Canmore. There are numerous hiking and biking trails in the area and our scheduling allows our staff leisure time to explore the great outdoors.

The following positions are available for our winter 2010 and summer 2011 seasons:

Cook

Meals are served buffet style and focus on fresh, home made food that nourishes our guests and leave them asking for the recipes. Dining is a very important aspect of a guest's stay and we receive numerous comments on the great food here at the lodge.

The cook is responsible for breakfast and dinner preparation as well as preparing sandwich bread. A weekly food order is completed by the cook and received by the cook. The cook is also responsible for the overall cleanliness of the kitchen and food storage areas.

Cooks must have current Alberta Food Safe training.

Lodge Help

Lodge help encompasses many roles at the lodge. Daily duties include setting the tables, preparing various foods for the buffets such as fruit salad or baking fresh cookies, clearing and washing dishes, overseeing laundry, cleaning the lodge and rooms while taking care of our guests with a smile.

There is a very close team that pitches in to ensure everything is completed daily and that we all have time to relax and enjoy during our shifts.

Lodge help generally work 10 days on and then have 4 days off. This schedule can be flexible to meet the needs of the employee.

Part-time Afternoon Tea Attendant

The lodge is open to the public and many visitors drop by to see the lodge during the summer months. Responsibilities would include baking loaves or cookies, preparing our home made dips, overseeing afternoon tea and taking care of visitors and guests. Hours for this position would be 12pm to 5pm, with afternoon tea being served from 3pm to 5pm.

As this is a part-time position, the candidate would be commuting to the lodge for their daily shifts.
